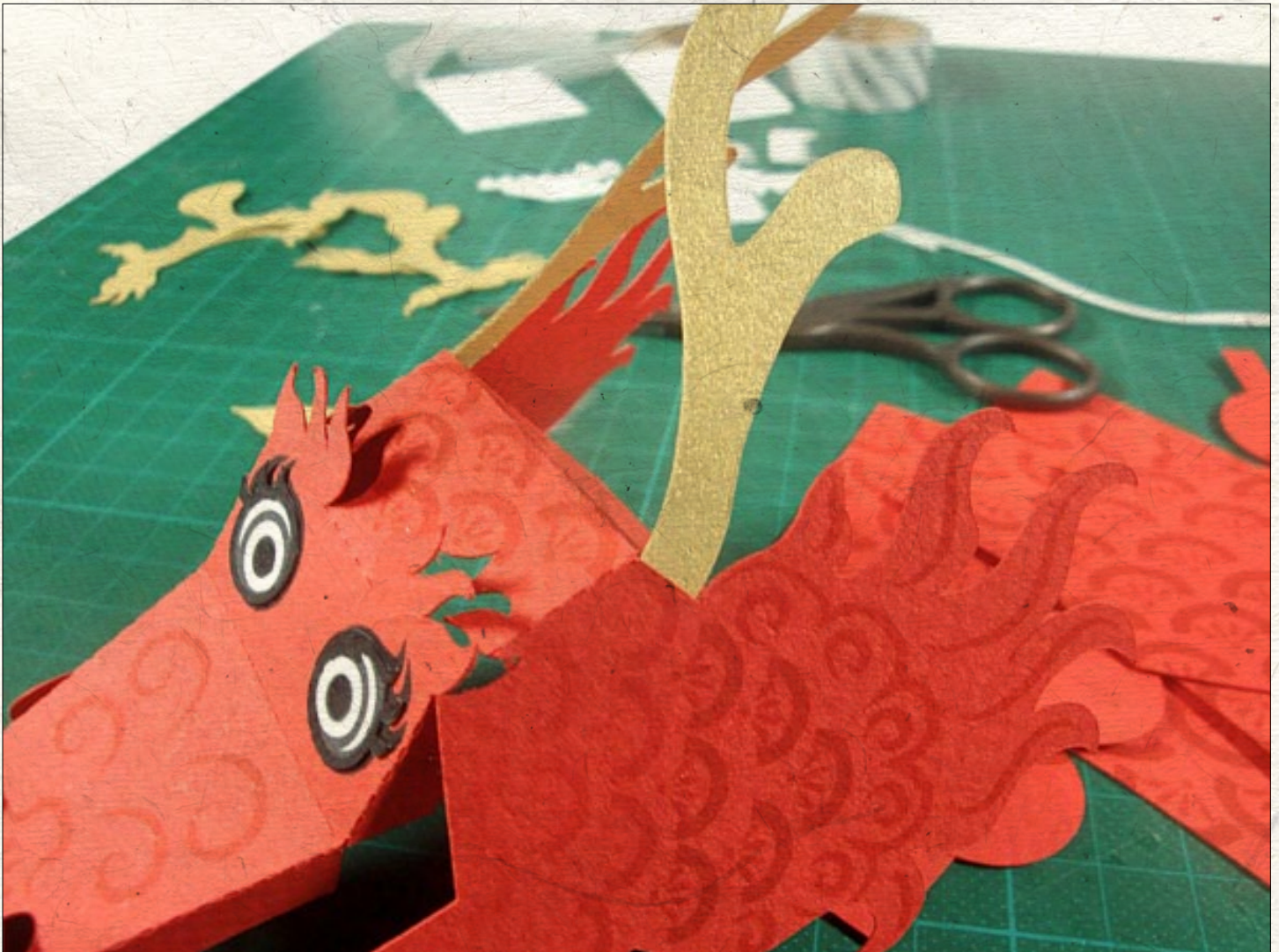
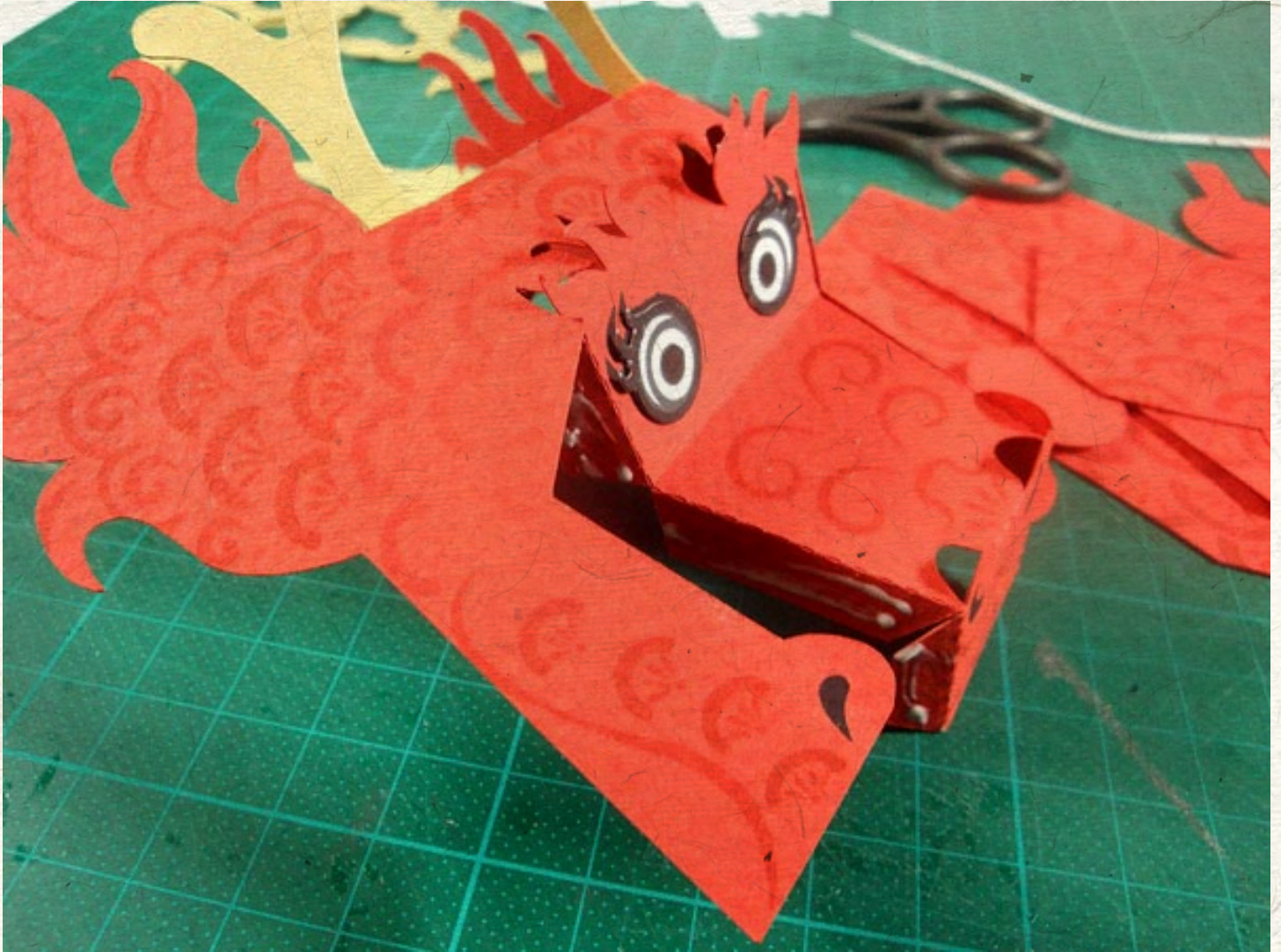




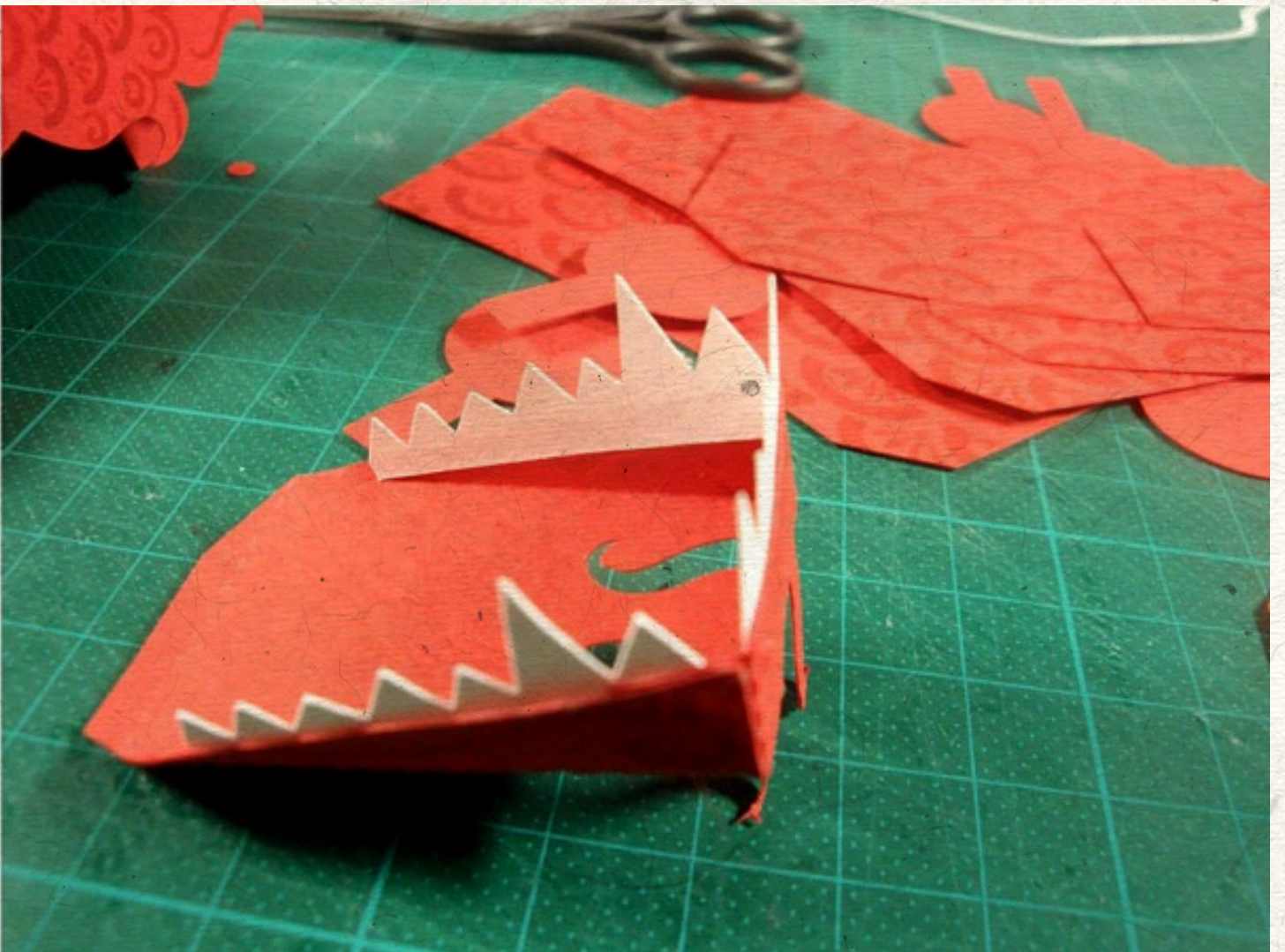
You will need two skewers, glue, xacto knife, some tape and some string. Start by cutting out all the parts.



Pre-crease the head on the dotted lines. Attach the antlers to the head before glueing it together.



Glue together the front parts of the head as shown. Let it dry.



Meanwhile, assemble the lower jaw and attach the teeth.



Then attach the tongue. I decorated the head with additional feathers, but they are optional.



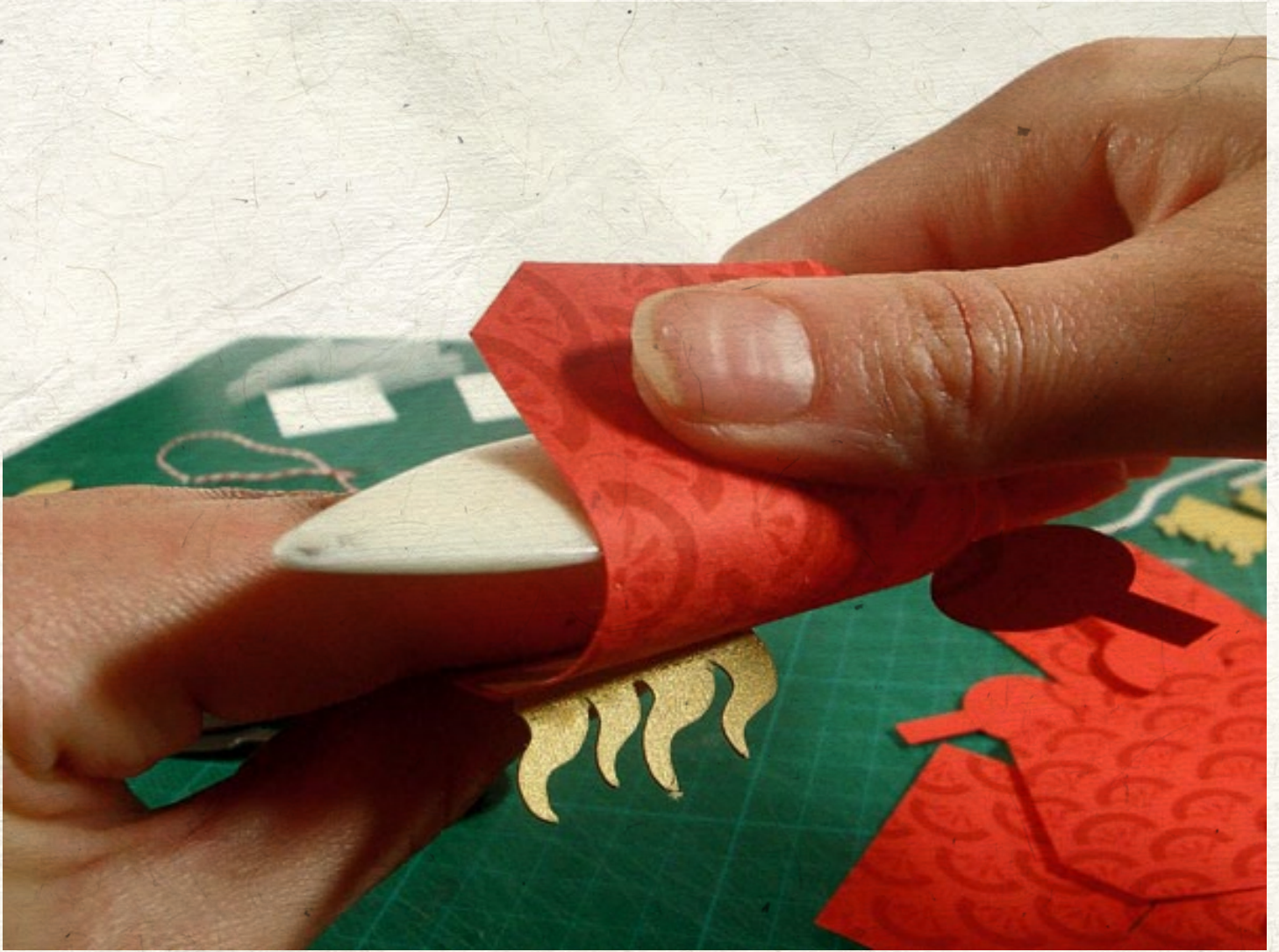
Before glueing together the back of the head, attach the string through the smaller hole and fix it with tape.



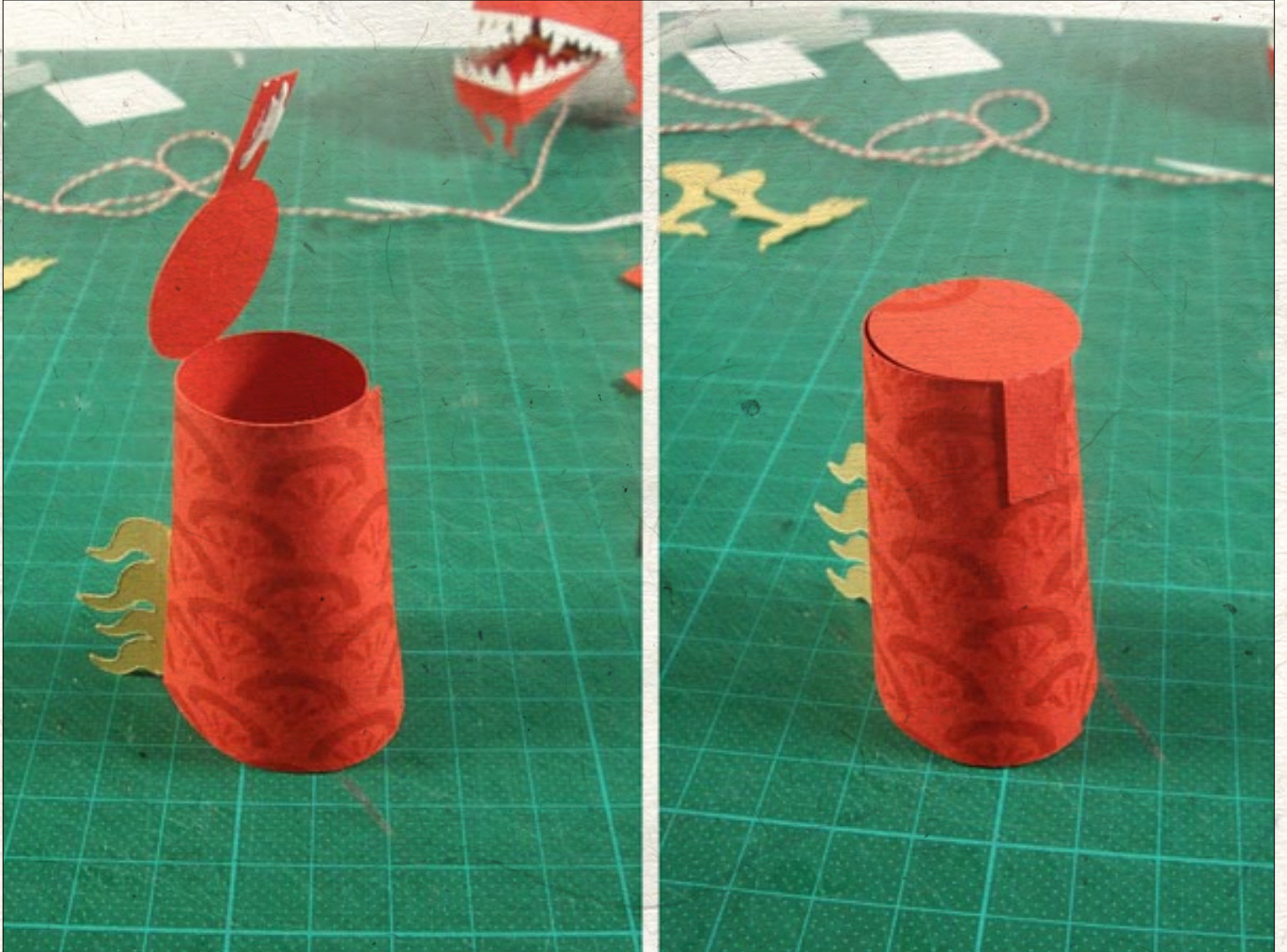
For the body, start by attaching the crests into the slits on the cones.



You can stabilize the slits with tape. That way, the cones will stay in shape.

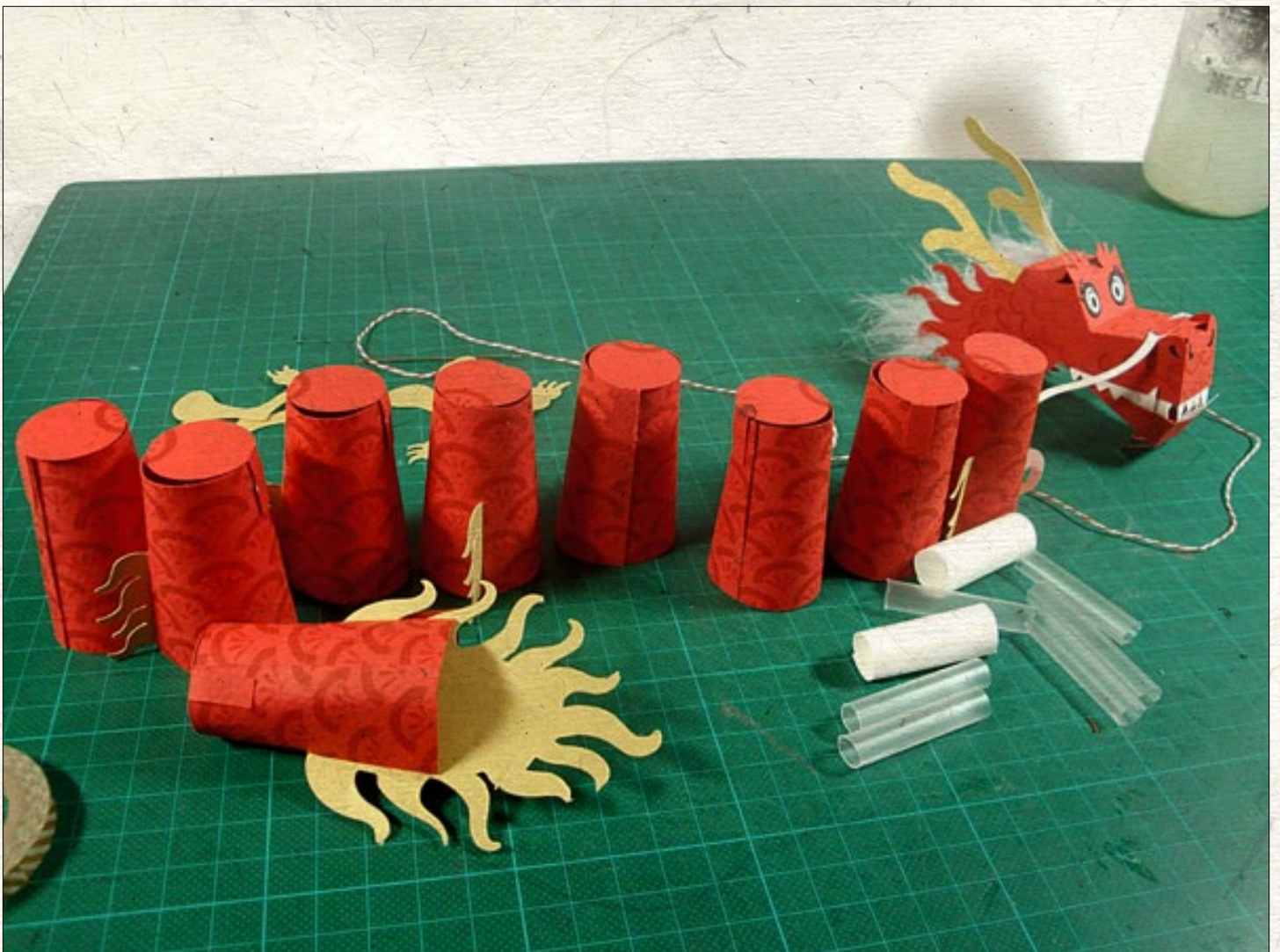


Form the cones by rolling the paper over a folding bone or a pen.





Form the spacers with a pen. If you want, you can omit them and just use a straw cut to the right length.



Attach the whiskers to the head. This is how it should look now. Almost done.



Thread the body parts and the spacers in turns. Sorry for the bad photo.



Stick the head onto a skewer and fix it with glue or hot glue. Attach the other skewer to the tail.



Glue the legs on each side of the body.

And you're done!
